Key Stage 4 Art

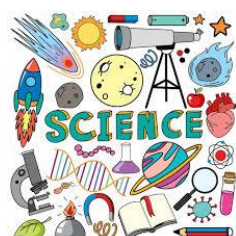
After school sessions continue to take place after school on a Wednesday.

Thursday's 3.40-4.30pm in HE2 Room: All pupils making M6/7 module only.



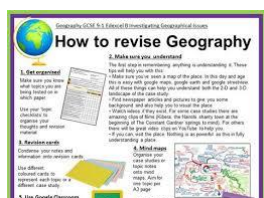
Key Stage 4 Science

Mrs Lynch will be delivering after school revision sessions every Monday 3.45 - 4.45pm. Pupils will receive a revision pack to be used in school and at home.

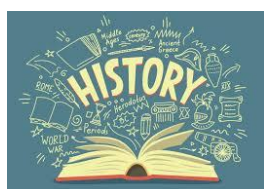


Key Stage 4 Geography
